Who is God?

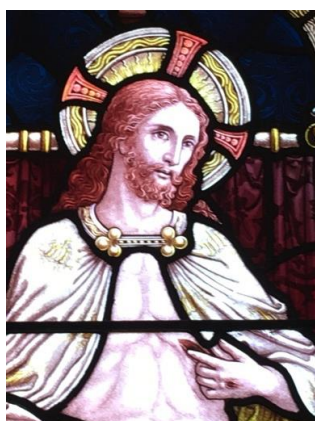
How did everything come to be?

Father, Son, and Holy Spirit

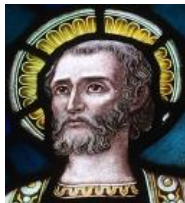


The Family Prayer

We are not perfect—yet

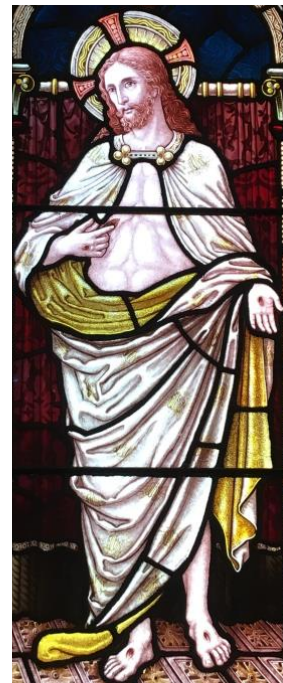
There isn't anyone on earth who does only what is right and never sins

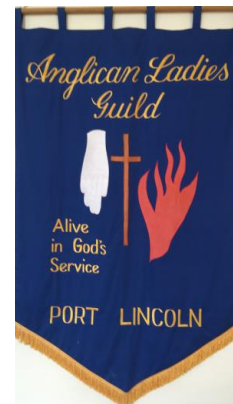
